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1. Package Contents

Thank you for purchasing PLANET Vertical IP-based Switched Power Manager, Vertical IPM-Series. "PDU" mentioned in this quick installation guide refers to the Vertical IPM-Series.

Open the box of the Vertical Switched IPM and carefully unpack it. The box should contain the following items:

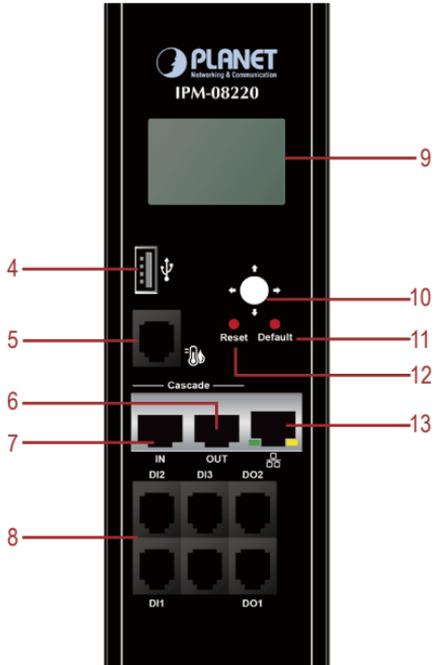

3. Product Appearance Description

3.1 Front Panels



No.	Item	Description
1	Overload Protection Switch	When the PDU is overloaded, the protector automatically disconnects the power supply to protect the electrical equipment.
2	LED Indicators	Indicates the operating status of the power output port
3	Power Output Socket	Each power socket can connect to electrical devices with the current less than 10A. The total output power is less than 16/32A. If the power output exceeds the maximum load, the PDU and electrical devices may be damaged and the circuit breaker protection function may be triggered.
4	USB interface	Extend the USB function port
5	T/H Sensor Ports	External temperature and humidity sensors can be connected through RJ11 ports.
6	Cascade Output Port	Cascaded output with other PDUs through RJ45.
7	Cascade Input Port	Cascaded RJ45 input to other PDUs.
8	Sensor Interface	Sensor interface can be connected to access control, smoke, alarm and other devices.
9	LCD Displays	LCD is used to display PDU status information.
10	Interface Selection Button	Used to control the menu function of LCD.
11	Default Switch	This switch is recessed and must be pushed with a thin object, such as the end of a paper clip. You can press this button and hold it for more than 3 seconds to reset the PDU to factory default values. Release this switch and restart the device to take effect.
12	Reset Switch	Hold down the key to restart the PDU.
13	LAN Port	It can connect to 10M/100M Ethernet network. Control and access PDUs.



Please follow the steps below for installing the power input socket.



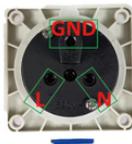
1. As shown in the picture, remove the 4 screws from the socket.



2. Separate the nose from the fuselage and remove the nose.



(1) Loosen the contact screws. (2) Mark according to the pin.



(3) Insert the wire core and tighten the contact screws.

3. Connect the L, N, and GND wires of the cables as shown in the figure, and tighten them to prevent virtual connections caused by loosening.



4. Connect the head and the frame, and tighten with screws.

4. Hardware Setup

The PDU can be installed indoor in a server cabinet. To install the PDU in a position, use the fasteners and screws delivered with the device to set up the PDU.

4.1 Installation

To install the PDU, perform the following steps:

- Step 1.** Properly ground the PDU using ground cables. Connect one end of the grounding cable to the grounding terminal and the other end to the appropriate grounding object.
- Step 2.** For each group of devices to be connected, use their power cables to connect the AC socket of the device to the available socket on the PDU.
- Step 3.** Connect the cable that connects the PDU to the network connection port of the PDU.
- Step 4.** Connect the PDU power cable to the AC power supply.

After connecting PDUs, power on PDUs and connected devices.



Note

1. Do not omit **Step 1**. Proper grounding can avoid damage caused by surge or static electricity.
2. Do not plug the PDU power cord into the extender of multiple sockets to prevent it from being unable to get enough power to operate properly.
3. It is strongly recommended that you use harness straps and cable boxes to secure cables to the front panel of the equipment. Prevent loose and poor contact in subsequent time.

4.2 Rack Mounting

Please note the following items when performing rack installation.

1. When extending the device out of the rack, ensure that the rack is smooth and stable.
2. Do not overload the AC branches that supply power to the frame; the carrying capacity of the whole frame should not exceed eighty percent of the power of the branch.
3. Make sure that all equipment used on the rack – including power strips and other electrical connectors – is properly grounded.
4. Ensure that proper airflow is provided to devices in the rack.
5. Ensure that the operating ambient temperature of the rack environment does not exceed the maximum ambient temperature specified for the equipment by the manufacturer
6. Do not step on or stand on any device when servicing other devices in a rack.

5. Web Login

5.1 Starting Web Management

Step 1: Log in the web setting page of PDU

Enter the IP address of PDU (e.g., <https://192.168.0.10>) in the address bar using the https method of your PC's web browser.

The default user name and password are both **admin**.

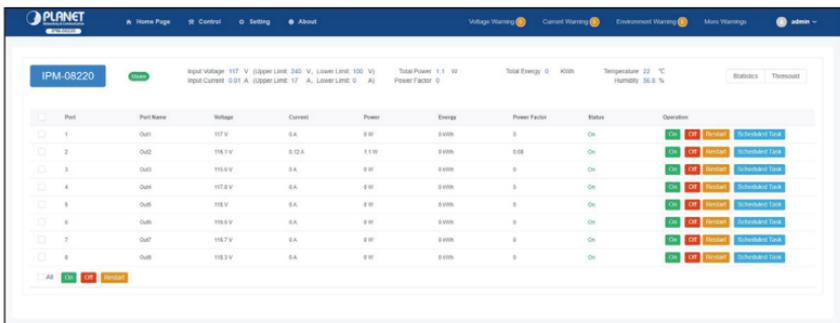

After logging in, you will be required to change the password. The password must contain 8-32 characters, including upper case, lower case, numerals and other symbols. Please note that spaces are not allowed.

After logging in, the top panel of the page provides the following options for

PDU operations: Home Page, Control, Statistics, Settings, and About. Click the corresponding TAB to select, set, and view the functions provided on the corresponding page.

Step 3: Network Configuration

To configure the network, perform the following operations:

1. Click the **Setting** TAB.
2. The device configuration page is displayed. A screen similar to the following should appear:



3. Please fill in the field data according to the information provided in the device setting instructions of **Network Setting**.

Step 4. Change of administrator Log-in

To change the default user name and password of the administrator, perform the following operations:

1. Click the User List in the User Management button at the top of the screen. A list of users is listed on the left side of the user administrator page, with their more detailed information displayed on a large block in the center.



2. In the Administrator information section, select Edit to reset the unique name and password, and then click **Save** (bottom of the page).

If you forget the administrator account and password, please reset the PDU to restore the initial settings and the default administrator account.

6. PDU Discovery through PLANET NMS Controller (NMS-500/NMS-1000V)

The IPM-08220/IPM-16230 is the vertical IP-based Switched Power Manager which can be centrally monitored by PLANET NMS Controller.

Follow the steps below to discover the managed PDU through PLANET NMS controller (NMS-500/NMS-1000V). Please ensure NMS and each managed PDU use a different static IP in the same subnet before physically connecting to the managed network.



Note

Please regularly check PLANET website for the latest compatible list of the controller/managed PDUs in each firmware version.

Step 1: Launch the Web browser (Google Chrome is recommended.) and enter the default IP address <https://192.168.1.100:8888> of the NMS controller. Then, enter the default username and password **"admin"** to log on to the system.

* The secure login with SSL (HTTPS) prefix is required.



Step 2: Go to the **"Domain"** page to discover and add the managed PDU to the device list. Then, you can search and go to the **"Device List"** and **"Topology View"** page to monitor the managed PDU.
